Dear friends and brothers, receive a cordial greeting from our family. God has given us a new year full of opportunities and new challenges and we want to continue sharing with you what God is doing in our lives and in our ministry

New Property

First, we want to share with you what God is doing in the prosperity of the Word of Life, since, as you know, that is where we live. We received the first work group of the year, which focused on the construction of new cabins and recreation areas that will be located next to the camp. It is a land that the ministry acquired but it still does not have buildings, so we have to start from scratch. This group came from Ohio and was with us for two weeks. We pray that this project can be finished soon and we can show you the final result of this project.

Bible Clubs

As for the Bible Clubs, we continue working in the deep South area of the country, Word of Life focuses on helping local churches specifically with youth and adolescent ministers, and for this year we have the challenge of being able to also help the ministry of children, providing training to leaders, materials and activities so that these ministries can be better developed. In the last regional concentration of leaders in our area we had the attendance of 50 leaders, from the different churches with which we work in the South.

CCM. (Ministerial Training Center)

We also continue working in the Ministerial Training Center (MCC) in the area we call "Ministry" supervising that each student can be in their local church serving and putting into practice what they have learned during the week. We work more closely with some students who have been assigned to us in the area of biblical counseling. We have also been able to teach some classes. All students are preparing for a mission trip at the end of May. There are three groups which are preparing to go and be part of the missionary work in parts of the country where there is a need to continue preaching the gospel.

In activities

The women's conference in the month of February, it is our second year holding it and it has been a great blessing, this year we received 315 women during a weekend.

This year the children's camp was called Explorers. And we had the Safari theme, we were able to receive 502 children and many of them were able to give their lives to Christ.

During the missionary conference, 9 missionary projects currently working in the country were announced, in addition to the word of life. Projects where the church can also be a part.

We had the opportunity to work hand in hand with the Filters of Hope ministry for 3 weeks. Bringing water filters to needy families and also preaching the gospel to them. We were able to visit more than 600 houses
