The MacPhail-Fausey's Church D2R, Cameroon Update and Prayer Letter

April 2026: Thank you so much for praying for our trip. Although we had several flight connections, some with short layovers, we did not miss any flights, and our bags reached all their destinations without delay. We also remained healthy throughout the trip even after returning. God provided strength and endurance and even protected us from circumstances that we could not foresee. We had already left Cyprus for Cameroon when the British air base received a drone attack. Please join us in prayer for the safety of our friends, Jörn and Sheila Lange, who are missionaries in Cyprus.

Cyprus is a beautiful place with an interesting history, and we cherished our time at the Pause conference catching up with fellow missionaries from Europe and Africa while making new acquaintances. Mark Cizauskas, pastor at First Baptist Church Rochester, MI, encouraged us with lessons from Habakkuk and passages in John focused on Jesus' ministry to women. We were richly fed both body and soul giving us strength for the hectic schedule in Yaoundé.

We were delighted to return to Yaoundé and received an enthusiastic welcome from our dear friends at *Sola Publishing*. The nine days we spent in Cameroon flew by with several reunions, planning sessions, and meals with friends. The first Sunday in country we spent at Bethlehem Baptist Church. We surprised many of our friends and received many hugs. Throughout the week, we had planning sessions at *Sola Publishing* for the upcoming printing and publishing activities, the details for the July Pastor's Conference including selecting books to be given away and setting the 3-year course curriculum for Sola Bible School. The first course, Hebrew, commences April 13th. We were able to observe the progress on the church building at Akak, with Pastor Frank Titi, which now comfortably seats over 70. We helped lay a ceremonial first stone on the new church property in Obam purchased by Pastor Daniel Bessala for his church plant in a growing area of Yaoundé. We concluded our trip with Bryan preaching at the church in Ahala which houses the Pastor's Conference. We filled our suitcases empty after delivering the supplies to *Sola Publishing* with our remaining belongings for the travel home. Much was packed into our time in Cameroon.

We eagerly anticipate returning to Cameroon this summer. The Pastor's Conference in Yaoundé will run July 20-24. Conrad Mbewe, Daniel Patz and Bryan will be speakers at the conference. Please continue to pray for their travels, for necessary visas, for message preparation, for good health and for the financial assistance required for a successful conference. We hope that 200 pastors will attend and 80% cannot afford the low conference fee especially those coming from outside Yaoundé. Please consider providing the fee of \$50 for a pastor to attend. We trust in the Lord and in His provision.
