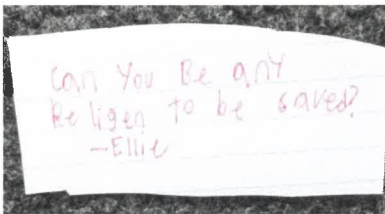
## Amy's RBM Prayer Letter
